## TRAVEL ONLY IN THE RIGHT PLACES



- Ride only in areas open to sand duning.
- Use maps and signs to help you ride in the right areas.
- Keep control of your motorcycle, ATV, or golf cart.
- Watch your speed—don't ride too fast.
- Don't jump hills or dunes unless you get the "all clear" from an adult.
- Watch out for unstable sand—it is dangerous.
- Don't ride or walk up streams.

## RESPECT ANIMALS, PLANTS, AND PEOPLE

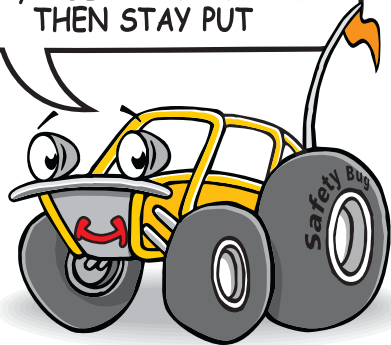
- Always pay attention to where you are and who else is around.
- Don't chase, scare, feed, or try to pet Lightfoot™'s animal friends.
- Don't run over plants.
- Keep the noise down, especially in camp.
- Don't ride or run through other camps.



## EVERY TIME YOU GO OUTDOORS, THINK SAFETY, BRING A FRIEND, AND BE PREPARED

- If you leave camp, always tell an adult where you are going and when you will be back.
- A grown-up should be with you when riding ATVs, dirt bikes, or golf carts.
- Stay with an adult! It is easy to get confused or lost in the dunes.

IF YOU THINK YOU ARE LOST, RIDE TO A HIGH POINT THEN STAY PUT



- Remember to ride like Lightfoot — in control.
- Wear helmets and other protective gear and/or a seatbelt.
- No double riding on ATVs.
- Ride ATVs and motorcycles that fit your size.
- Don't wander off at night.
- Remember to pack

these seven important items: water, food, first aid kit, raincoat, flashlight, sunscreen, and a whistle.

- Go to school — take an ATV or motorcycle safety course. Some areas require it.

## ALWAYS LEAVE THE OUTDOORS BETTER THAN YOU FOUND IT

- Don't litter or leave food or trash behind.
- Pick up trash left by others— as long as it is safe.
- Don't pick plants, flowers, or take rocks.
- Clean up after your pets.



## DISCOVER HOW FUN THE OUTDOORS CAN BE WHEN YOU TREAD LIGHTLY!

- Keep your parents and the rangers happy— follow all the rules.
- You will have more fun if you keep the dunes clean.
- Make the right choice—if you do something wrong others might follow and make more damage.
