Highway Licensed Vehicle Routes RECOMMENDED VEHICLES*

- Secondary Highway: Only for vehicles that are both highway licensed & equipped
- Paved Road: Only for vehicles that are both highway licensed & equipped
- Improved Gravel Road: Only for vehicles that are both highway licensed & equipped
- Improved Dirt Road: Only for vehicles that are both highway licensed & equipped
- Unimproved Road: Not recommended for passenger cars

Vehicles that are both highway licensed & equipped

 - 2WD High Clearance
 - 4WD High Clearance
 - Motorcycle
- Non-Highway Legal
- 4WD High Clearance
 - ATV
 - Motorcycle

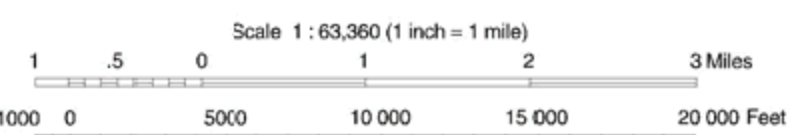
OHV Routes

- OHV Trail: High clearance vehicles, ATVs and motorcycles
- Motorcycle Trail: Motorcycles only
